

CARING FOR LEATHER FURNITURE

Care for your leather furniture properly so it stays beautiful and comfortable for years to come. Keep your furniture looking its best by vacuuming frequently to remove loose dust and debris.

Read the manufacturer's care instructions for your leather furniture. Carefully follow instructions. Do not use oil soap or saddle soap on leather furniture. These products stain furniture.

Do not clean your leather furniture with soap and water if expressly prohibited by the manufacturer. Instead, follow the manufacturer's care instruction.

Test old leather furniture for a protective or semi-aniline finish. Place one or two drops of water on an inconspicuous location of your leather furniture. Watch to see if the water is absorbed. Seal your furniture with water repellent if the water is absorbed quickly.

Clean unsealed leather furniture with care. Vacuum dust and debris from your furniture on a regular basis. Wipe the furniture with a clean, damp cloth. Blot stains with a soft, dry cloth soon after they are made.

Wipe sealed furniture with a mild soap and water solution. Dry the leather with a soft, clean cloth. Clean your furniture on a regular basis or as needed.

Remove difficult stains with a leather cleaning product. Contact furniture manufacturer for recommendations on the best product for your furniture.

Prevent your leather furniture from fading prematurely by placing it away from direct sunlight. Keep your furniture away from head vents or other heat sources to prevent the leather from drying out over time.
